- Organisational chart of the company, containing at least the positions set out in the "Human Resources" section of this protocol, indicating the professional membership of the authorised technicians.
- Powers of the legal representative requesting accreditation.
- Registration in the Commercial Registry.
- Registration in one of the following headings of the Tax on Economic Activities (IAE):
 - Heading 843 "Technical services (engineering, architecture, geology, topography, delineation, ...)"
 - Heading 843.1 "Technical engineering services".
 - Heading 843.2 "Technical architecture services".
- Proof of being up to date with payments with the Treasury.
- Registration with Social Security.
- Proof of being up to date with payments with the Social Security.
- Occupational Risk Prevention Plan implemented in the company, specifically including the possibility of conducting visits, inspections or technical assistance on site, for the appropriate personnel.
- The general contracting conditions for the building structure consultancy activity.
- Report or proof of standard operating procedures and quality control mechanisms for consulting work on building structures.
- Software inventory for the building structure consultancy activity.
- Security protocols for company information and backup copies (or data backup).
- Civil liability insurance with coverage for the building structure consultancy activity throughout the year and proof of payment.
 - Documentary proof (through certification or specific contracts) of at least one of the following requirements, executed during the 12 months prior to the accreditation request:
 - Five building structure consultancy projects or management/technical assistance in the structures phase.
 - Having conducted structural consultancy for a built area of at least 100,000 square meters.

In addition to these general requirements, when requesting accreditation in the building structure consultancy activity, the company also undertakes, through a sworn declaration, to strictly respect the requirements and methodology set out in the sections on human resources, material resources, client relationship, and control of the supplied equipment of this accreditation protocol.

This certificate is valid from the date of issue until 31 March, 2026.

The Association of Building Structure Consultants (ACIES) is an independent, non-profit association, recognised by the General Directorate of Labour with deposit number 99005839, according to the resolution published in the Official Gazette of the State of Spain.

ACIES is also the representative entity of the building structure consultancy activity for business organisations and professional groups.

At a national level, ACIES is part of the Federation of Construction Guilds (GREMIOS), and through this, the National Construction Confederation (CNC) and the Spanish Association for Standardisation (UNE).

In its role as regulator of this business activity, following the good practices recommended by the European Union and the example of other European countries, ACIES has established a protocol for the accreditation of companies in the building structure consultancy activity, after formal consultation with related agencies and entities.
